PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the city of Walla Walla welcomes people of all backgrounds and recognizes that the diversity of its people is one of its greatest strengths; and

WHEREAS, the city of Walla Walla has a thriving Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Nonbinary, Two-Spirit, Intersex, Asexual, and Queer (LGBTQ+) community; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ people contribute to the cultural, civic and economic successes of the City in immeasurable ways; and

WHEREAS, the month of June was chosen to commemorate the dedication and bravery of the LGBTQ+ people who, in 1969 at the Stonewall Tavern in Greenwich Village, sparked what later became the gay liberation movement; and

WHEREAS, June 2025 marks the 56th annual celebration of LGBTQ+ Pride Month throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ Pride Month is a time to reflect on the trials the queer community has endured and to rejoice in the triumphs of trailblazing individuals who have bravely fought, and continue to fight, for full equality; and

WHEREAS, Pride is both a jubilant communal celebration of visibility and a personal celebration of self-worth and dignity; and


WHEREAS, all citizens should be free to take pride in their identities and never feel they must hide who they are at work, school, or within their families and communities,

Mari Gisele

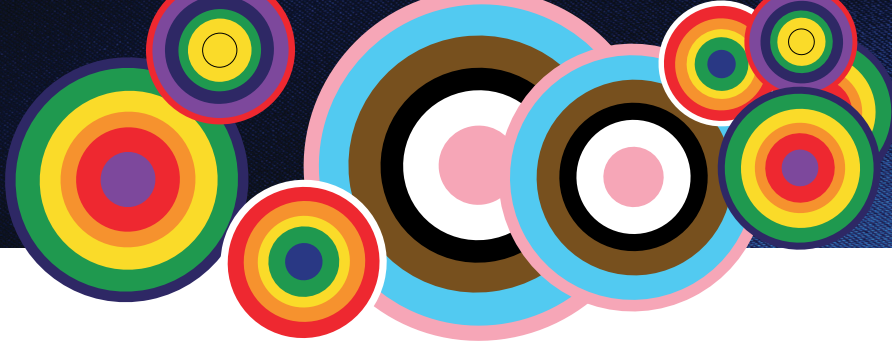
