WHEREAS, all citizens deserve to feel safe and proud in their identities at work, in school, and throughout our community;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Gustavo Reyna, Mayor of the City of Walla Walla, do hereby proclaim June 2026 as:

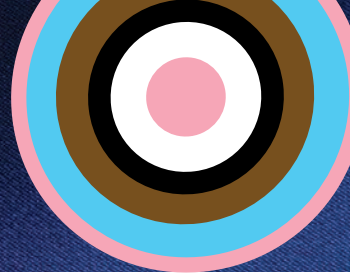

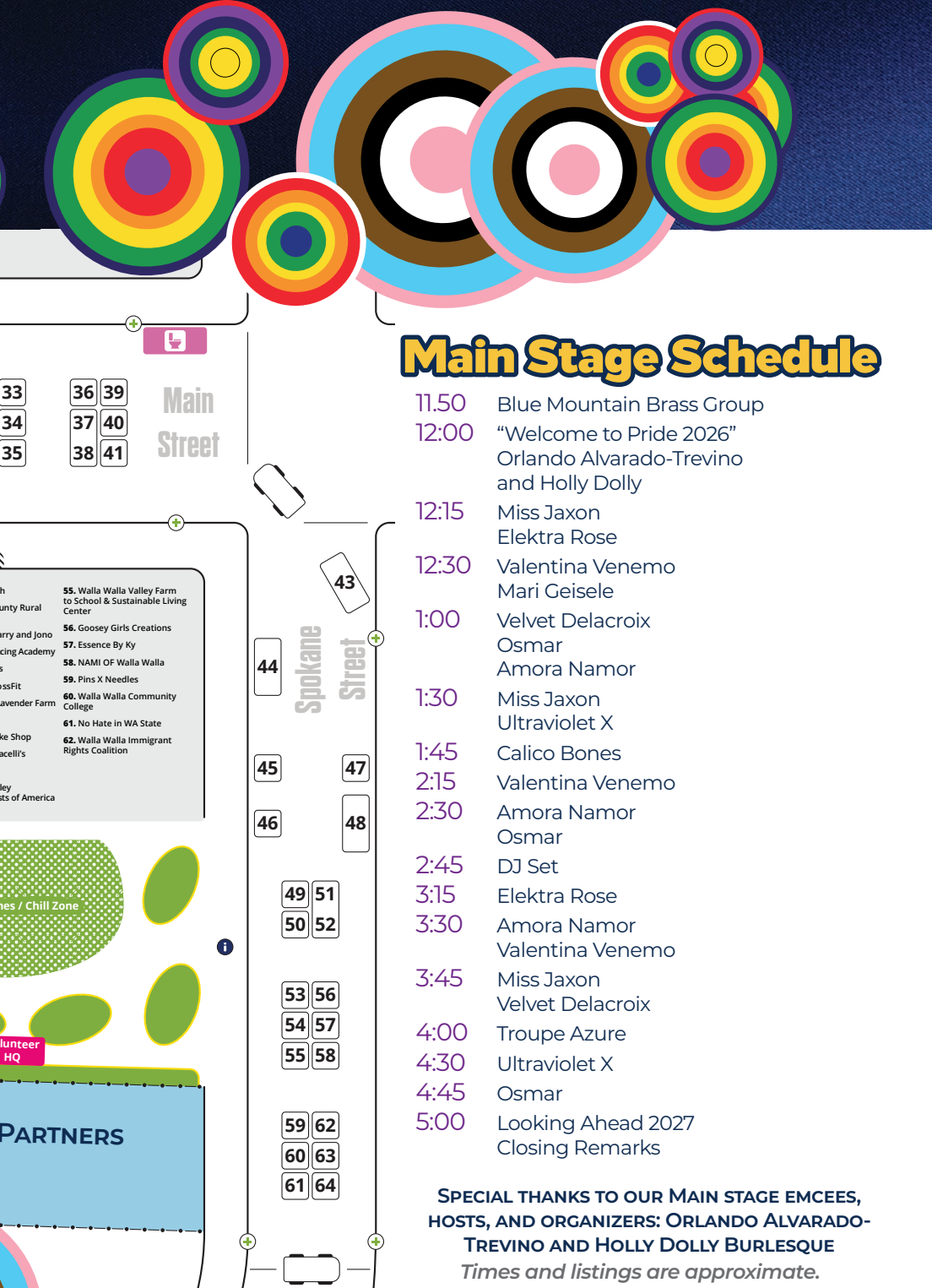

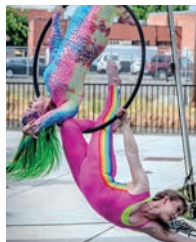


## Troupe Azure

Velvet Delacroix & Luna come together to deliver a special treat. Turning their aerial hoop world on its side to bring you along for a magical ride on their "chandelyra".

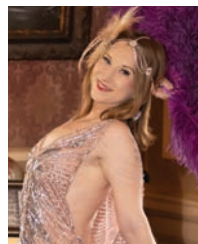


## Valentina Veneno
